Although same gender schools are considered too conservative and strict in today's time. Nevertheless, there are still supporters of this manner of education. Some parents are not in favour of co-educational system as they feel that the presence of opposite gender distracts the attention of students and prevents them from concentrating on studies.

On the other hand, supporters of co-education feel that as boys and girls are different, it is a valuable experience for both genders to communicate with each other. Moreover, the earlier boys and girls to communicate, the sooner they acquire social skills, which are crucial to communicate freely in the world. Further, if there are girls in the class, boys may well possibly try to behave better in order not to lose face in front of the girls.
